

The Lord's Prayer

Outline from Dr. Larry Lea's "Could you not tarry?" Annotated by Gilbert Ybarra

1. OUR FATHER WHICH ART IN HEAVEN

- Picture Calvary and thank God that you can call Him "Father" by virtue of the blood of Jesus.
- Form a mental picture of the blood shed by Jesus on the Cross. (Ephesians 2:13; 1 John 1:7)

2. HALLOWED BE THY NAME

- Praise God for who He is and for what He has done for us.
- Hallow the names of God corresponding to the five benefits in the new covenant.

SIN - forgiveness of sin (<i>Jer 23:6; 1 Cor 1:30; 2 Cor 5:21</i>)	JEHOVAH-TSIDKENU	"Jehovah our righteousness"
(<i>Leviticus 22:32 1 Peter 2:9</i>)	JEVHOAH-M'KDDESH	"Jehovah Who sanctifies"
SPIRIT -fullness of the Holy Spirit (<i>Judg 6:24; Jn 14:27</i>)	JEHOVAH-SHALOM	"Jehovah is our peace"
(<i>Ez 48:35; Jn 14:15-17; Matt 18:20</i>)	JEHOVAH-SHAMMAH	"Jehovah is there"
SOUNDNESS - health and healing (<i>Ex 15:26; 1 Pt 2:4</i>)	JEHOVAH-ROPHE	"Jehovah heals"
SUCCESS - freedom from the curse of the law (<i>Ge 22:14; Phil 4:19</i>)	JEHOVAH-JIREH	"Jehovah's provision shall be seen"
SECURITY - freedom from the fear of death and hell (<i>Ex 17:15; Jn 12:32; Is 11:10</i>)	JEHOVAH-NISSI	"Jehovah my banner"
(<i>Ps 23:1; 1 Pet 5:4; 1 Pt 2:25</i>)	JEHOVAH - ROHI	"Jehovah my Shepherd"

3. THY KINGDOM COME, THY WILL BE DONE, Pray for:

- Yourself and your family (spouse, children, other family members).
 - Be sure you are right before God. (John 14:23; Luke 6:46)
 - See Jesus sitting on the throne of your life, ruling in every area. (Revelation 11:17)
 - Abide before the Lord until the course of your day is set and the Spirit of God is functioning in you. (1 Pet 5:5)
- Your church (pastor, leadership, faithfulness of people, harvest of souls). Pray for Revival!
- Our nation (city, state and national political and spiritual leaders, harvest of souls). (Jeremiah 29:7)
- Pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Ps. 122:6).

4. GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD

- Be in the will of God (prayer life, church, work habits, obedience in giving).
- Believe it is God's will to prosper you. (Joshua 1:8; 3 John 2)
- Be specific and tenacious.

- d. Pray the Lord will plant you in your local church and make you a contributing, functioning, healthy part of that body.
- e. Examine your work habits. Are you slothful? A workaholic? Ask the Lord to give you ability, efficiency, might, and balance.
- f. Examine your giving. Are you obeying the Lord in bringing your tithes and offerings into the storehouse? Or are you greedy, stingy, or a poor manager? Do you pay your bills and have a reputation as a fair and honest person who keeps his word? Take time to pray along these lines.

5. AND FORGIVE US OUR DEBTS AS WE FORGIVE OUR DEBTORS

- a. Ask God to forgive you. (1 John 1:9)
 - 1. Deal with your sins. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal areas in your life that are not pleasing to God. Psalm 66:18
 - 2. Confess your sin. Agree with God and say what He says about your sin. Ask Him to help you hate the sin with perfect hatred and to deliver you from its dominion. Praise His name, JEHOVAH-M'KADDESH: "Jehovah who sanctifies." (Psalm 32:5)
 - 3. Do not allow condemnation. Remember: You are the righteousness of God in Christ. You are complete in Him. (2 Corinthians 5:21; Romans 8:1)
- b. Forgive and release others - set your will to forgive those who sin against you.

6. AND LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION, BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL

- a. Put on the whole armor of God (Put on the Lord Jesus Christ - Ephesians 6:10-18)
 - 1. Loins girded about with **TRUTH** (John 8:32; John 14:6; Psalm 51:6)
 - 2. Breastplate of **RIGHTEOUSNESS** (Isaiah 59:17; Isaiah 61:10; Isaiah 64:6; 2 Corinthians 5:21)
 - 3. Feet shod with the **PREPARATION (READINESS) OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE** (Philippians 4:7; 1 Peter 3:15)
 - 4. Shield of **FAITH** (Ephesians 2:8; 1 John 5:4-5)
 - 5. Helmet of **SALVATION** (Ephesians 1:22; Ephesians 4:15; Colossians 1:18)
 - 6. Sword of the Spirit, which is the **WORD OF GOD** (Hebrews 4:12; Revelation 1:16)
- b. Pray a hedge of protection around yourself and your family. (Job 1:10)

(The Lord is your refuge, your fortress, your God - Psalm 91:2)

 - 1. Because you have made the Lord your habitation (Psalm 91:9)
 - 2. Because you have set your love upon Him (Psalms 91:14)
 - 3. Because you have known His name (Psalms 91:14)

7. FOR THINE IS THE KINGDOM, THE POWER AND THE GLORY FOREVER

- a. Make faith declarations, be bold in faith - God hears and answers prayer. (John 5:14-15)
- b. Return to praise.
